The status of value assessments for 1/1/2019 increased from \$974,438,950 to \$987,185,211 an increase of \$12,746,261 (1.31%)

The status of value assessments for 1/1/2020 increased from \$978,185,211 to \$994,139,545 an increase of \$15,954,334 (1.63%)

The Township was issued a multiplier of 1.0107 for 2019 and a multiplier of 1.0054 for 2020

Growth five years ago was 5%

2020 worked on the new building plans and sight- the building construction will begin in summer 2021

Worked on Bridge deck drainage so that water runs down the bridge imbankment

Thanked everyone

There have been \$1.1 million dollars of capital improvements to ARC in 2019

Full HVAC update and finishing of 3,000+ of activity space on the west end of ARC and second floor which includes a large activity room and a small conference room

Second floor renovated spaces include a large community room, classroom, kitchenette and staff office

Purchased a ADA accessible van for transporting members with different mobility needs

\$12,000 grant to support the YWCA's new Special Needs After School Care Program located at Colene Hoose School

Township awarded \$5,000 John M Scott Grant to the General Assistance program to help with unpaid medical bills for residents of Normal at or below the poverty level

Acknowledge Jill Schaab's 15th anniversary as a caseworker and bookkeeper, Molly Camper for 17 years directing senior programs, and the ARC is 5 years old (April)

The Covid Pandemic brought many changes in 2020

Began a Sick Leave Program for part time employees of ARC and Township- worked hours accumulate into hours available for sick time off - 70% of staff was able to use these hours for time off due to a contagious illness

New Entry Management and program scheduling software (GymMaster) to manage entry into building, program registration and program payments- Key fobs were distributed to staff and ARC members

ARC created Digital Programming so that senior members could stay engaged with physical activity, cognitive skills and socializing 500 Zoom digital programs hosted- PEPs, tai chi, yoga, meditation, music enrichment, cooking demonstration, painting, book club, Ukulele, grief counseling, bingo, Memorial and Veterans Day services, Senior Scholar lectures, tech tutoring, durable power of attorney Information sessions, line dance and Parkinson support group along with many other programs

ARC staff made 9,000+ calls to members providing assistance and reassurance, wellness checks and birthday greetings

ARC hosted 11 blood drives with the American Red Cross- produced 366 life-saving units of blood

ARC's Senior Health Insurance Program (SHIP) enrolled 174 seniors in new, cost-saving prescription drug plans for 2021

ARC has provided tablets and webcams to help local seniors connect online through a grant from Illinois Care Connections Reduced elected official pay, reduced supervisor's salary by over \$10,000 per year which will result in further employment tax and retirement contribution savings

Received Funding for \$600,00 Solar Array for ARC building

Approved funding by the Illinois Solar For All (ILSFA) program

Solar array built by StraightUp Solar of Bloomington- the array will provide 65% in savings on electric costs- anticipating \$25,000 in savings for the first year and \$520,00 in next 15 years- the panels have a 25-year warranty and life expectancy of 30-35 years- the Township will own the array at the end of 6 years

Township received \$46,400 in grants-\$22,000 ECIAAA Sunshine, \$17,000 Cure-\$2,400 IPCF for art program and \$5,000 John M Scott for medical assistance

Provided \$5,000 to help fund the Youth Empowered School program for high risk high-school students at Normal Community and Normal West with full time specialists to provide support to improve student engagement and achievement

Township partnered with Care BroMenn Hospital and McLean County Health Department- January 2021 through April 2021 to provide Covid Vaccinations at the ARC with ARC staff providing assistance to scheduling for vaccine appointment- 12 clinics administering 5800 doses for first and second doses- last clinic is April 16, 2021

Ed Pyne asked what vaccine was distributed- used Pfizer and Moderna which are both 2 doses
